- Staff 7: B# (1 or 3 or 5), C (2 or 4 or 6), C# (1 or 3 or 5), Db (2 or 4 or 5), D (1 or 3 or 4), D# (3 or 2), E (2), E# (2), F (2), F# (2), Gb (2)
- Staff 8: G (1), G# (3), Ab (2), A (3), A# (2), Bb (3), B (2), B# (1), C (1)
